IL-MESSAĠġ TAL-MADRE PROVINċJALI
SR CLAUDIA ZAMMIT



Għeżeiż Qarrejja,

Ninsabu f'dan iż-żmien tal-Avvent, ġranet li jgħinuna biex inħejju l-qalb tagħna għall-miġja tat-tarbija ta' Betlem f'qalbna u fi djarna. Dan iż-żmien hekk sabiħ u qaddis tal-Milied kien isaħħar lill-Venerabbli Fundatriċi tagħna Madre Margerita. Hija kienet tibda tiċċelebrah kmieni fl-Avvent bi thejjija xierqa, u dan kien jimliha b'entuż-jażmu qaddis u b'ħeġġa mqanqla mill-fidi. Waħda mis-sorijiet li ħallitilna x-xhieda tagħha fil-“Positio”, jiġifieri fil-ġabra ta' fatti miġbura dwar Madre Margerita li tressqu lill-awtoritajiet tal-Knisja fil-mixja lejn il-Beatifikazzjoni u l-Kanonizzazzjoni tagħha qalet hekk: “Fl-Avvent kienet tkellimna spiss dwar l-umiltà u l-faqqar ta' Ģesù Tarbija”.

F'xhieda oħra minn reliġjuża qalet li Madre Margerita, fi żmien l-Avvent, kienet tistieden lis-sorijiet biex jiċċelebraw b'ferħ fratern it-tweliid ta' Ģesù. Kienet tgħidilhom, l-aktar lejlet il-Milied: “**Kollox għandu żmienu. Żmien il-Milied, mhuwiex żmien il-Passjoni u allura jeħtieġ li nkunu ferħanin**”. Hawn ninnutaw kemm Madre Margerita kellha f'moħħha u f'qalbha t-tifsira vera taż-żmien liturgiku tal-Avvent, dik ta' stennija ferħana u mimlija mħabba. Nistgħu wkoll nġibu quddiem għajnejna, din l-istennija ferħana li kienet għexet il-Verġni Marija, Omm Ģesù, hekk kif kien qed joqrob il-jum li twelled lil Binha Ģesù.

Ninnutaw li Madre Margerita ma kinitx imqanqla biex titħejja għall-Milied u biex tiċċelebrah minn sempliċi entuż-jażmu li jintefha mill-ewwel hekk kif tgħaddi l-Festa. Hija kienet tkun imqanqla mill-fidi tagħha fl-Inkarnazzjoni tal-Iben t'Alla li sar bniedem u għammar fostna l-bnedmin għall-imħabba, bl-imħabba u fl-imħabba. Din l-imġiba tagħha kienet theggixha biex b'imħabba iktar qawwija “**ħobb l-Imħabba u biex tagħmilha magħrufa u maħbuba minn kulħadd u kullimkien.**”



Qrib il-Milied tal-1931 kitbet hekk: “nilmħu ‘l Alla, li jinżel mill-ħdan tal-Missier Etern Divin u jiġi jieħu s-sura fqajra tagħna l-bnedmin u jgħix bħal wieħed mill-ifqar”.

Quddiem dan kollu, staqsiet: “Inħarsu lejn Ĝesù Tarbija fl-għar... x’jgħidilna? Araw xi mħabba għandi għalikom!” Hija proprju din l-imħabba li t-Tarbija ta’ Betlem tixtieq taqsam magħna għax Hu twieled biex jgħix f’dinja imperfetta fejn jeżistu l-iżbalji u nies bid-difetti, jitwiegħed fejn hemm il-faqar u l-miżerja. Ĝie biex jurina kemm aħna għeżeż għaliex bid-difetti kollha tagħha.

Il-Milied iġib il-paċi u l-ferħ anki fejn wieħed ma jkunx jistenna li dan iseħħi. Niftakru li l-ferħ mhux xi ħaġa tax-xorti jew tad-destin. Il-ferħ issibu meta tgħix fil-preżenza t'Alla, tirringrażzaH kull filgħodu għall-miraklu tal-ħajja, għal kemm tqassam u tgħaddi l-paċi ma’ kull min tiltaqa’, kemm tgħin lil min hu fil-bżonn, kemm lest li taħfer lil min naqsek, u kemm tħobb lil dawk li jweġġgħuk bl-għemil tagħhom. Madre Margerita tgħidilna, huwa l-eżempju ta’ “Kristu li umilja ruħu bil-kbir meta sar tarbija u twieled f'għar kiesaħ u f’tant faqar imsaħħan biss min-nifs ta’ żewġ animali” li jisfidana biex ħajnej tkun mibnija fuq l-eżempju tiegħi.

Għalhekk ma naqtgħux qalbna u nkomplu nibnu ħajnej tkun fuq il-pedament sod ta’ l-altruwiżmu billi dejjem infittxu l-ewwel il-bżonnijiet u l-ferħ ta’ ħutna li ngħixu magħhom, bil-ftehim ta’ bejnietna, bil-mogħdrija u l-maħfra, bit-trobbija ġelwa u soda, billi tnaqqas il-konflitti li jinqalgħu, bit-twemmin sod u b'fiduċja fil-Mulej waqt li tgħix il-ħajja nisranija fit-talb u bis-sehem tiegħek fis-Sagamenti. Dan kollu jrid jissaħħa bl-imħabba li ma tafx limiti, li tagħti bla ma tistenna li tirċievi lura u li tkun lest għal kull sagrifikkju.

Meta twettaq dan, tifhem aħjar li l-Milied huwa l-festa tal-Iben t'Alla li sar bniedem, kiber u miet għalija biex inkun nista’ ngħix għal dejjem.

Madre Margerita u l-Milied

L-ispiritwalitā ta' Madre Margerita hija waħda Kristo-Čentrika. Hija kienet tikkontempla lil Ģesù fit-tliet misteri principali jiġifieri Ģesù f'Betlem, fuq il-Kalvarju u fl-Ewkaristija. Illum ser naraw fil-fond kif Madre Margerita kienet tikkontempla l-inkarnazzjoni ta' Ģesù. Tajjeb ngħidu li kienet thejji ruħha b'fidi kbira għall-festa tal-Milied.



Matul il-ġranet tal-Avvent hija kienet tgħix kull ġurnata bi thejjija għall-jum tal-Milied billi tikkonċentra l-ħarsa tagħha dwar aspett partikolari fuq livell spiritwali. Qed nir-referi għall-'corradino'. Dawn huma ġabra ta' ħsibijiet fejn takkumpanja lil Marija li qed tistenna t-tweliż ta' binha billi thejji fost oħrajn il-ħwejjeġ, is-sodda u magħhom tgħaqqa xi ġakulatorja jew azzjoni filwaqt li ttendiha diversi drabi matul il-jum. Hekk Madre Margerita kienet thalli l-ħsibijiet tagħha cċentratu fuq it-thejjija għat-twelid tat-tarbija Ģesù. Din hija drawwa qaddisa li għadha ssir sal-lum issir minna s-sorijiet Franġiskani tal-Qalb ta' Ģesù.

Mill-kitbiet li ġallitilna l-Fundatrici, naraw b'mod ċar l-umanità tagħha. Matul iż-żmien tal-Avvent, hija timxi m'Ommna Marija tul it-tqala tagħha, bit-thejjijiet li mara li qed tistenna tarbija tagħmel. Dan jidher b'mod ċar f'waħda mill-ittri tagħha fejn kitbet: "Issa li aħna fi żmien l-Avvent, inħabirku ħalli nagħmlu libsa sabiħa lill-Imqaddes Bambin; inħejju n-nar għall-ghażiża Ommu Marija ħalli jkollha biex issaħħan il-Bambin li ser jitwieled." Dawn l-affarijiet kienet thejjijhom permezz tal-

'Corradino'.



Aktar ma kienet tikkontempla l-Misteru tal-Inkarnazzjoni, Madre Margerita kienet tiffoka fuq l-Imħabba kbira t'Alla, li minn Alla, iċċekken u sar tarbija. F'ittra tagħha nsibu: "Jalla l-Imqaddes Ģesù Bambin jagħmel li nkunu nixbħuh, hekk ċnejknin. Għax meta nkunu ċnejknin inkunu qed nogħġbu... Ejew nifirħu mal-Maħbub tagħna divin, li ried li jsir ċnejken għall-imħabba tagħna! Inħobbu, iva inħobbu, għax l-imħabba m'għandiekk prezzi." Il-missjoni personali ta'

Madre Margerita kienet dejjem li tressaq lill-bnedmin lejn Alla u li tagħmel lil Alla magħruf u maħbub minn kulħadd. Dan l-aspett ma kienx jonqos f'dan iż-żmien fejn kienet tagħmel emfasi fuq l-Imħabba t'Alla għall-bniedem u kemm il-bniedem għandu jkun rikonoxxenti lejn Alla u biex jagħmel ħiltu li jwieġeb għal din l-imħabba bl-imħabba. Tistieden ukoll biex il-bniedem fuq l-eżempju t'Alla ma jitkabbarx bih innifsu iżda jagħraf ix-xejn tiegħu u l-kobor ta' Alla.


Fl-awguri li Madre Margerita kienet tibgħat fi żmien il-Milied permezz tal-ittri tagħha, naraw li kienet tippreżenta lis-sorijiet il-virtujiet tat-Tarbija ta' Betlem biex ifasslu l-ħajja tagħhom fuq dan il-mudell hekk kbir! Hija tikteb hekk: “**Infittxu li nitgħallmu l-virtujiet sbieħ tal-Imqaddes Ģesù Bambin, l-aktar l-Imqaddes faqar, is-semplicità, l-abbandun f'idejn il-Providenza Divina.**” Bħala persuna Franġiskana, Madre Margerita ma setax jonqos li l-ħarsa tagħha tkun fuq il-faqar, is-semplicità u l-abbandun, liema virtujiet kull Franġiskana hija mistiedna li tagħmel tagħha.



Ġesù Tarbija mhux biss ftaqar li minn Alla sar tarbija, iżda nafu tajjeb li t-tweliid tiegħu ma sarx ġo xi palazz lussuż mimli bin-neċċessitajiet iżda kien f'daqsxejn ta' għar imwarrab minn kulħadd u li fih lanqas l-aktar affarijiet bżonnjuži ma kien hemm! Fl-istess faqar nistgħu naraw is-semplicità, fejn ma tweliidx lil xi mara nobbli ta' dak iż-żmien iżda lil daqsxejn ta' tfajla sempliċi u umli! U xi ngħidu għall-abbandun? Minkejja li kien Alla, intelaq f'idejn Alla l-Missier ħalli ssir FiH ir-rieda Tiegħu!

F'dan iż-żmien qaddis tal-Milied, il-kontemplazzjoni ta' Madre Margerita tistedinna biex: “**Fi żmien hekk prezżjuż nisktu f'hemda qaddisa u nħallu biss li**

titkellem l-Imħabba. L-imħabba t'Alla li ssir bniendem, li ssir Tarbija! U aktar, issir Ostja Ċkejkna. Irid ikollok wisq fidi ċkejkna biex ma tmutx bl-imħabba." Il-ħarsa ta' Madre Margerita hija dejjem fuq l-imħabba t'Alla lejna l-bnedmin u kif dan Alla mhux biss ċċekken u sar tarbija, iżda baqa' jiċċekken saħansitra f'ostja ċkejkna. F'silta oħra mill-kitbiet tagħha nsibu: "L-imqaddes Missier ta' dejjem, hekk ħabbna li wasal biex tana Rigal hekk prezjuż, kif hu tabilhaqq l-Iben il-Waħdieni. Għandna tassew għax immutu bir-rikonoxxa lejn Imħabba hekk Kbira! Inħobbu billi nissagħrifikaw il-ġibdiet tagħna, dak kollu li jmiss lilna, il-kumditajiet kollha." Mill-kontemplazzjoni, Madre Margerita kienet tasal għall-azzjoni. Hijha ma tqażix biss fuq x'għamel Alla għalina iżda timxi pass 'l quddiem billi tindika kif nistgħu nwiegħbu għal din l-imħabba billi nibdlu l-imġiba tagħna.



Nagħlaq dawn il-ftit ġsibijiet bil-kelmiet ta' Madre Margerita għal dan iż-żmien lil soru li kienet qed tieħu ġsieb it-tfal orfni. "L-awguri sinċieri li nagħmillek tal-Milied li dalwaqt magħna huma dawn: li inti titkebbes b'dak in-nar kollu qaddis ta' mħabba safja lejn l-imqaddes Ģesù Bambin u b'dan l-istess nar jirnexxielek li tkebbes il-qlub kollha ta' dawk it-tfal. U hekk it-twajjeb Ģesù jkollu kuruna ta' innoċenti li jsabbru f'tant niket li jirċievi mingħand ħafna u ħafna midinbin ingrati."

Jalla aħna wkoll għeżeż qarrejja, ngħixu dan iż-żmien bl-istess spirtu li għexitu l-għażiżha Fundatriċi tagħna Madre Margerita biex il-ħarsa tagħna tibqa' ffokata fuq Ģesù Bambin u ma niqfx biss fuq il-konsumiżmu li xi kultant ikaxkarna.

News from the sister island

St Francis School, Gozo

The scholastic year started very smoothly, thank God, in contrast to last year's and all the children were ever so happy and enthusiastic to return to their stable scholastic life providing stability and safety.

On the 18th October 2021 we joined children from around the world as we prayed the Rosary for peace and unity. Each



class prayed in front of the statue of Our Lady of Lourdes in the schoolyard, while the other classes joined us online.



Starting on the 19 October our school participated in the 10-day Litterless campaign with schools from around the world. This campaign encourages students not only to reduce the harmful effect on the environment by reducing waste themselves but also to raise awareness of this within their communities. There were 7 actions to be completed both at home and at school, among them a Zero-waste day at school/home where we were very careful to use only re-usable items, clean-ups around the countryside and on beaches, raising awareness among the public on plastic pollution, also explaining the harm detergents are doing and preparing alternatives with simple everyday things. The year 3 students also gave out cloth bags to passers-by, especially sewn by staff members. The school and families put up posts of the actions they were carrying out, so that the message would reach far and wide. One of our entries was also one of the three entries chosen from among all the schools in Malta and Gozo, to be sent abroad to compete with other entries from around the world. A survey carried out by Year 4 students found that we buy so many things just for the sake of buying and not because we need them. And so they collected items – particu-

larly stationery – bought at the beginning of the scholastic year, but which had not been used, and donated it to Fr Anton in Guatemala.



The school also celebrated the European Week of Sports Activity by dedicating the 29 October to different Sports Activities in the school gym for each class. The students were taught the importance of moving about, instead of living a sedentary life, and how important it is for our health to participate in Sports activities regularly.



We are making the most out of the permission we have been granted by Health authorities this year to take the children out on educational outings. The junior classes have been out on fieldwork, Maths trails and the like, while the early years, including Kindergarten have turned the public garden, the beaches etc into outdoor classrooms and have been having numeracy and literacy lessons in the open air.



On October 26 we held the customary Pink October day at school, where students and staff alike wear something pink and make a donation toward Breast Cancer research. However this year we added another tint – orange – and also celebrated ADHD awareness day. So some children opted for orange clothes instead. The money collected was sent to ADHD Malta and to the Hospice Movement.



On November 17 we also linked another 2 important events – World Children's Day (which this year fell on a Saturday), and Anti-Bullying Day. The children wore orange tops and odd socks. We started the day off with an "Anti-Bullying" Assembly. Each class from Kinder 1 to Year 6 held different activities throughout the day, preparing posters and online messages against bullying, focusing on this year's theme "One Kind Word". Each child made a donation which was distributed among various entities including bBrave organization, the Church Schools Children's Fund and to needy families in Gozo. In this way it was not only the students of our school who benefitted from this day, but also many others outside the school, including those who access the school's facebook page.

Smart Kids Of Digital World

The Erasmus project 'Smart Kids of Digital World' is a three-year project launched in 2019 in an effort to explore innovative ways how to encourage children to spend their free time away from technological devices, while promoting ways and means to use technological devices wisely when needed. Children in today's world can get easily hooked on playing online games and meet friends virtually, without realizing that they are spending hours on the phone, tablet, computer or PlayStation. Hence, this project aims to strengthen social skills and promote a healthy, balanced child development with various activities that encourage strong relationships through one's origins, culture and history. Moreover, it also aims to develop positive attitudes towards responsible use of digital tools at home as well as encourages self-control in the use of ICT.

Four schools from different countries are taking part in this Erasmus+ Project – Turkey; who are the coordinators, Poland; Spain and Malta. After holding online meetings between partners, our students have experienced the benefits of digital communication when they virtually met foreign students live during lessons at school. National traditions were shared and children learned about other cultures. Meetings and seminars with parents were held and activities were also disseminated and uploaded on the eTwinning portal, the school's Facebook Page and the Facebook Project Page.

The first mobility for this project was held in Turkey in December 2019, where our school's IT representatives attended training and specific seminars together with the Turkish partners. Following that, various classes took part in works and activities re-

lated to the project theme whilst Year 3 and Year 5 students from our school took part in activities that highlighted the benefits of using technological devices wisely in everyday life. Year 3 students used 'Quiver' to create drawings that virtually came to life after being scanned with the tablet's camera. Year 5 students used mapping skills and directions to code a simple programme using 'Scratch Jr' on their Learnpad. These activities were then presented during the second mobility in Poland, held in October 2021.

The next mobility will be held in February in Malta. Our students and staff are preparing to welcome our partners through various activities that will be held both in the school premises and outside, encouraging cultural knowledge and responsible use of digital tools. The final mobility will be held in Spain during the month of May.

The project will come to an end next year. Through this project we as teachers have learned to use new digital tools that help make teaching more interesting. Moreover, students have been exposed to different cultures. On the other hand, students have participated in traditional games that move away from the digital world but still they were engaged in other activities that encourage effective learning through technology. It is indeed a wonder how the good use of digital tools enables new learning experiences and makes new friendships from different parts of the world possible!
